

**Karawang, August 2023** – PT Pindo Deli Pulp and Paper Mills highly values and understands the importance of protecting the environment and ensures that our operations always remain within the regulatory boundaries set by the Government.

During the visit by the Environmental Law Enforcement (Gakkum) team from the Ministry of Environment and Forestry (KLHK) on Wednesday, August 23, it was found that Non-Hazardous and Non-Toxic Waste (Fly Ash Bottom Ash/FABA) generated from the power plant was being utilized as road base material within the factory premises. This activity is currently in the process of administrative approval. The utilization of Non-B3 (FABA) waste has been temporarily suspended by Gakkum and may resume once the administrative process is completed. In the meantime, the Non-B3 (FABA) waste will be managed in cooperation with a licensed third party. As of now, the company's operations continue to run normally.

We take the Government's concerns regarding air pollution control very seriously and are fully committed to cooperating with the Ministry of Environment and Forestry (KLHK) and other relevant parties to ensure that all concerns and recommendations raised are addressed promptly, effectively, and appropriately.

PT Pindo Deli Pulp and Paper Mills also ensures that it has established incident response protocols and continuously improves all operational activities in accordance with applicable laws and regulations at the district/city, provincial, and national levels, to ensure business continuity and uphold our commitment to all relevant stakeholders.
