



1st Stakeholder Advisory Forum 5 October 2015

ATTENDEES: APP and partners. Local, national and international stakeholders.

SCOPE: The SAF brings together APP, local, national and international organizations and other relevant stakeholders to discuss, address issues concerning, and to develop solutions related to, the implementation of APP's Forest Conservation Policy (FCP) and its landscape conservation initiative. The SAF will also raise issues and propose solutions pertaining to Indonesia's forest landscape as a whole.

Summary of Stakeholder Recommendations

1 HCV & HCS Management & Protection

1. Strengthen communications and engagements with law enforcement, communities, and government agencies to address third party clearance.
2. Develop strategy to strengthen security on corridors / access that poses high risk for illegal activities. Those identified to have been used for illegal activities need specific strategy.
3. Strengthen engagement and collaboration with government to address the issue of land mafia and land use overlap.
4. Develop a strategy to empower and incentivize the communities so they are able to protect natural forest more responsibly.
5. Improve APP's fire management strategy

2 Peatland Best Management Practice

6. Develop specific peat management mechanism for areas that are adjacent to the conservation areas.
7. Optimize water level to conserve peatland and develop programs for alternative species
8. Collaborate with local communities to implement canal blockings.
9. Assess peatland to identify areas for rehabilitation and rezoning
10. Anticipate and develop plans to address dry seasons to avoid peatland fires

3 Free Prior Informed Consent (FPIC) & Social Conflict Resolution

11. Ensure that relevant staffs have the required capacity to be able to conduct proper negotiation with the community. Ensure the community receives complete information and
12. proper advice during negotiation. Monitoring by independent observer is encouraged. APP should provide progress updates on its action plan
13. related to improving their contractors' and sub-contractors' staff rights and welfare.

4 1 Mio Hectare Forest Protection & Conservation

14. APP should engage the government to facilitate Master plan socialization to ensure it is understood and accepted by all stakeholders. This master plan will be the guideline for stakeholder conservation program.
15. APP should ensure that the landscape conservation initiatives are align with the program from Directorate of Essential Ecosystem Management of Ministry of Environment and Forestry.
16. Government's Forest Management Unit (KPH) program is a suitable platform for landscape conservation initiative and should be integrated in the 1 million ha conservation program.
