SAF3 RECOMMENDATION FOLLOW UP



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LANDSCAPE AND
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

RECOMMENDATION:

Local communities need to be consulted to define what they expect from the FCP and the landscape approach.

FOLLOW UP :

Local communities have always been engaged and consulted in every step of the FCP implementation process.

RECOMMENDATION:

APP to further develop its IFFS program to provide support to the farmers

FOLLOW UP :

- “ APP has been implementing the IFFS program since the beginning in 2016. Participatory discussion with the local communities has been maintained.
- “ Social experts from Gadjah Mada University have also been engaged to provide feedback and further refine the IFFS program.
- “ As of May 2017, 75 villages have implemented programs under IFFS.

RECOMMENDATION:

APP should draw on indicators used in international best practices.

FOLLOW UP :

- “ Currently developing methodology to measure impacts of the landscape conservation programs funded by Belantara.
- “ Involving experts and the draft methodology will be consulted through a public consultation process.

RECOMMENDATION:
Define long-term goals.

FOLLOW UP :

- “ APP’s Sustainability Roadmap : Vision 2020 already sets out a list of targets that APP wants to achieve by 2020.
- “ Belantara Foundation have developed Strategic Plan document for 2017-2021, which defines the goals and the organisation’s plan to achieve its goals for the next 5 years.
- “ Based on this strategic document, action plans for the landscape on the provincial level have also been completed in all five provinces.

RECOMMENDATION:

APP should support the Forest Management Units (FMUs).

FOLLOW UP :

Continue **providing capacity building** programs to all of its suppliers, including consultation with the related experts (TFT, Deltares, CIFOR, ICRAF, Gadjah Mada University, Forestry Research and Development Agency/FORDA, etc.)

RECOMMENDATION:

A multi-stakeholder approach at the local, regional and national level, APP should (1) empower local communities leaders; (2) use evidence-based approaches; and (3) build industry-wide collaborations.

FOLLOW UP :

- “ In order to make positive influence, Belantara Foundation is working with provincial governments to establish **Joint Secretariat (SEKBER)** as a platform to synergize and coordinate all stakeholders’ programs in the landscape.
- “ Through SEKBER Belantara can also **identify the gaps** in the landscape level that needs further addressing (i.e. no program currently focusing on that particular issue.)



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MANAGEMENT OF
SOCIAL CONFLICTS

RECOMMENDATION:

NGOs should propose improvements to the current strategy on conflict resolution.

FOLLOW UP :

- “ Based on communications with NGOs, **a workshop will be arranged at the end of 2017** to reflect on and discuss on different practices of conflict resolution in APP suppliers’ concession.
- “ The result of this workshop can be **used for learning** in other areas and to improve the conflict resolution system.

RECOMMENDATION:

Set up a panel of NGOs and APP representatives to monitor a sample of conflict resolution processes.

Set up a network of regional platforms to share experience among different stakeholders on best practices in social conflict resolution

FOLLOW UP :

APP has set up a **regional social working group** on provincial level.

2. Palembang in June 2017



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PEAT MANAGEMENT
BEST PRACTICES

RECOMMENDATION:

Set up a working group dedicated to peatland management: (a) identify a pilot landscape as agreed in MUBA Landscape - Musi Banyuasin Regency in South Sumatra for peat pilot, (b) define and agree on the working group governance rules and management

FOLLOW UP :

TOR for for Peat Expert Working Group has been completed and the potential names to be involved have also been identified.

RECOMMENDATION:

Stakeholders should provide options for improving law enforcement on water management at national and local level

FOLLOW UP :

- “ Improving law enforcement on water management is the Government’s domain, developed and enforced by Government.
- “ As a stakeholder, APP continues to actively participate in the discussion whenever invited by the government.



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OTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

RECOMMENDATION:

Define clearer responsibilities at HQ down to operations

FOLLOW UP :

In order to improve coordination, quality control, response, monitoring and evaluation, **a new department and pool of experts (Centre of Excellence) has been established** to act as a bridge between HQ, R&D, Planning and Operation divisions.

RECOMMENDATION:

Increase exchange of experience from local champions

FOLLOW UP :

APP has implemented a mechanism for cross sharing and cross learning through a platform called **Management by Olympic System (MBOS)**.
